



***Draghi sends strong signal that ECB will act**

European Central Bank President Mario Draghi pledged on Thursday to do whatever was necessary to protect the euro zone from collapse, sending a strong signal that inflated Spanish and Italian borrowing costs were in his sights. Fears about the euro zone's future are intensifying with Spain and Italy facing frenzied pressure on financial markets and Greece holding crunch meetings with its international lenders having failed to keep its repair plans on track, raising fresh questions about its place in the currency bloc. With the need for urgent action becoming increasingly apparent, the ECB appears to be gearing up to flex its muscles, something Madrid and Rome have been seeking for months

***Spanish unemployment rate reaches record high of 24.63%**

Spain says its unemployment rate for the second quarter of the current year has reached the record high of 24.63 percent. According to the new figures released by the government of Friday, nearly 5.7 million Spaniards are now out of work. The country also says that almost 53,500 people lost their jobs between

April and June alone. The jobless rate is up from the first quarter's 24.4 percent, despite the usual spike in tourism. Earlier, the *three Spanish regional communities of Valencia, Murcia, and Catalonia asked for financial aid from the central government in order to keep paying their debts.*

***Drought diminishes mighty Mississippi, puts heat on Congress**

A drought in Russia is destroying the country's 2012 grain harvest, the Russian Agricultural Ministry said Thursday. In the Krasnodar territory, in southernmost Russia on the Black Sea, the first to report figures, the grain crop is about a third of last year's totals, the ministry said. "Such an unfavorable year has not been witnessed since the second world war," said Yuri Tkachenko, head of the Krasnodar weather forecasting center. The immediate effect of the lowered crop yield is a severe reduction in Russian exports of grain and corn, Russian news service ITAR-Tass reported Thursday.

***First West Nile case reported in NY as virus hits 17 states**

A 50-year-old Staten Island man is the first person in New York to be diagnosed with West Nile virus this year, according to a statement from the New York City Health Department. That brings the total number of states reporting cases of West Nile in 2012 to 17. Most cases have occurred in southern states, including Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi and Oklahoma, but the disease has been reported in Minnesota and South Dakota, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Not including the New York man, 182 people have been reported to have West Nile, and two have died from the disease, the CDC says. The deaths were reported in Texas and Arizona.

***Burnt shirt sparks Egypt sectarian clash, police say**

Muslims on Friday set fire to Christian homes in a village near the Egyptian capital after a fight between a Muslim man and a Christian laundry worker who singed his shirt while ironing it, police said. At least one person was wounded as Muslims and Coptic Christians also traded fire bombs, police officials said. Muslims have in the past burned the homes of Copts during sectarian clashes, with dozens of Christians killed in the past 18 months alone since president Hosni Mubarak's overthrow in a popular uprising.

The Copts, who make up roughly 10 percent of Egypt's 82-million-strong population, were also targets of sectarian attacks before Mubarak's ouster in February last year.

***New report suggests summer storms could create new ozone holes as Earth warms**

Summer storms may create new holes in our protective ozone layer as *Earth heats up*—bringing increased solar ultraviolet radiation to densely populated areas, a new study says. What's more, if more sunlight reaches Earth, skin cancer could become the new marquee risk of global warming. As the planet warms, some studies have suggested summer storms may become more frequent and intense. This would send more water vapor—a potent greenhouse gas—into the stratosphere, the middle layer of Earth's atmosphere, which sits between 9 and 22 miles (14 and 35 kilometers) above Earth's surface.

***DARPA, NIH to fund 'human body-on-a-chip' research**

Researchers in the Department of Biological Engineering at Massachusetts Institute of Technology will receive up to \$32 million over the next five years from the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) and the National Institutes of Health (NIH) to develop a technology platform that will mimic human physiological systems in the laboratory, using an array of integrated, interchangeable engineered human tissue constructs. A cooperative agreement between MIT and DARPA worth up to \$26.3 million will be used to establish a new program titled "Barrier-Immune-Organ: Microphysiology, Microenvironment Engineered Tissue Construct Systems" (BIO-MIMETICS) at MIT, in collaboration with researchers at the Charles Stark Draper Laboratory, MatTek Corp., and Zyoxel Ltd. The BIO-MIMETICS proposal was one of two award winners selected as part of the Microphysiological Systems (MPS) program at DARPA, and will be led by MIT professor Linda Griffith in collaboration with MIT professors Steven Tannenbaum, Darrell Irvine, Paula Hammond, Eric Alm, and Douglas Lauffenburger. Jeffrey Borenstein and Shankar Sundaram will lead the work at Draper Laboratory, Patrick Hayden will lead the work at MatTek,, and David Hughes will lead the work at Zyoxel.

***Storms knock out power to thousands from Plains to Northeast**

Hundreds of thousands lost power due to a potent storm system that extended eastward from the Plains toward the Northeast on Thursday, bringing with it high winds and destructive lightning. Severe thunderstorm watches were in effect at one point Thursday evening for a continuous stretch from Oklahoma through New Jersey. The danger could lurk for several hours longer, with the National Weather Service issuing such warnings in Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, Kentucky, Virginia, Arkansas and other points in between. "Trees were bending sideways," a man in New Jersey says. The residual and more widespread damage came in the form of extensive power outages. More than 100,000 First Energy customers in Pennsylvania, for instance, didn't have electricity as of 10 p.m. ET, with other utilities like PECO and PPL reporting tens of thousands of others similarly in the dark.

*Arab League: Don't Touch Muslim Temple Mount

As Jews fast and mourn the Temple, Muslim Brotherhood members in Egypt will be protesting for "holiest site" on Temple Mount. by Maayana Miskin The Arab League has released a statement warning Israel to stay away from the Al-Aqsa Mosque. The mosque is located on the Temple Mount, which Judaism teaches is the holiest site in the world. Surprisingly, the Arab League statement termed the mosque "the holiest of the Arab and Islamic holy sites." Normally Mecca is considered the holiest site to Islam. The statement warned the "occupation authorities" against interfering with the mosque. "The city of Al-Quds [Jerusalem] and at its head the Al-Aqsa Mosque, is a red line that must not be crossed, and any attack on it will definitely endanger the safety and stability of the entire region," it stated. ***The Arab League's anger was aroused by what it termed an "extremist invasion" by police to check IDs and temporarily bar access to the mosque.*** A Muslim Brotherhood-linked doctors' association in Egypt plans to protest over the matter. Its demonstration will be held on Saturday night, as Jews mourn the destruction of the Temple. The association may be burning the Israeli flag just as Israelis circle the Temple Mount in the annual Tisha B'Av march.

*Muslims, Christians clash over Garden Tomb

A dispute over a holy place in Jerusalem is threatening the delicate status quo between Christians and Muslims in the Holy City, with Israel caught in the middle. The Garden Tomb outside the Old City walls, with an ancient tomb carved into a rock, resembles the place where Jesus was buried according to biblical accounts. Some Protestants believe it is the very place of Jesus' resurrection, though most archaeologists place the actual site at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher in the Old City. The serenity of the site has been disturbed by the expansion of a Muslim cemetery adjacent to the Garden Tomb. Though the construction

was approved by the Jerusalem Municipality, it is threatening the physical integrity of the Christian holy place, according to an investigative report by the Israeli daily newspaper *Maariv*.

***Barak Warns Israel Ready to Go It Alone on Iran**

Defense Minister Ehud Barak warned Wednesday that Jerusalem is "committed to doing everything it can in order to stop Iran from going nuclear." I am "fully aware of the difficulties and complexities involved in preventing Iran from attaining nuclear weapons," Barak told graduates of the IDF National Security College. Israel is facing "difficult and fateful decisions" in weighing methods to stop Iran's controversial uranium enrichment program, he said. Iranian officials contend that their program has only peaceful goals, but officials in Jerusalem, the West, and Gulf Arab states say Iran is pursuing nuclear weapons. Barak said "having to deal with the challenge" of an Iran possessing nuclear bombs "would be many times more complex, dangerous and costly, both in terms of human life and in terms of resources, than a preemptive strike." "But a look at the facts leads us not only to avoid reconsidering our calculations, but to move on our intended path with greater confidence," he added. Barak added: "the Iranians are determined to continue deceiving the entire world, in order to achieve nuclear weapons. Whoever wants proof just needs to look at the talks over the last few months, including the most recent talks in Moscow." He termed Iran's nuclear program "a unique challenge" to Israel "with the potential to develop into an existential threat."

***IDF on alert as Syrian fighting nears northern border**

***IDF reinforces Golan border, fearing Syrian terror attack**

Israel Defense Forces engineering units have been busy the past week bolstering security along the northern border with Syria in an attempt to prevent the possible entry of infiltrators and refugees as the fighting in Syria inches nearer to Israeli territory. Obstacles were placed along the border, security fences were

reinforced and deep trenches were dug to ensure that no one enters the country illegally. The deteriorating situation in Syria has become a mounting concern for Israel, which fears the unrest will spill over the border, and the long-quiet frontier area will become a new Islamist front against the Jewish state. The IDF has been monitoring the situation on the Golan Heights for some time, due to a concern that terrorists affiliated with the global jihad movement may be among those who try to enter the country.

***Hezbollah Places Itself at Assad's Disposal**

The Hezbollah terror group has affirmed its allegiance to Syria and has offered to place itself at President Bashar Assad's disposal. According to a report on Thursday in Lebanon's *Al-Joumhouria* newspaper, Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah "placed all of Hezbollah capabilities at al-Assad's disposal, in the event of the Syrian regime requiring urgent assistance." The newspaper quoted senior political sources as confirming that there had been contact between Assad and Nasrallah, and that "Nasrallah had offered al-Assad two forms of assistance, firstly he offered elements of Hezbollah's special forces any time they are needed, even if they are required to be sent to open fronts to fight the revolutionaries. Secondly, Nasrallah invited the Syrian president to his personal residence, or even to meet inside the Iranian embassy in Beirut."

***Syria preparing for massacre in Aleppo**

***UN worries showdown in Aleppo could be imminent**

President Bashar al-Assad's forces renewed a ground and aerial bombardment of Aleppo on Friday, extending efforts to crush rebels in Syria's commercial capital in what the United States said it feared could become a massacre. Insurgents targeted army roadblocks and security installations, with both sides avoiding close-quarters warfare in the city of 2.5 million people, Syria's biggest urban center. The U.S. State

Department said credible reports of tank columns moving on Aleppo, along with air strikes by helicopters and fixed-wing aircraft, represented a serious escalation of Assad's efforts to crush a rebellion that began 16 months ago.

***Helicopter gunships strafe Syria's Aleppo, rights group says**

Troops fired from helicopter gunships on several neighborhoods of Syria's second city Aleppo on Friday, as the army faced off against rebel fighters, activists told AFP. The Syrian Observatory for Human Rights said the army was using helicopter gunships in the southwest of the city, in the Salaheddin, Bustan al-Qasr, Sukari, Al-Mashhad and Al-Azamiya neighborhoods. Troops also clashed with rebels in the central Jamiyya district, adjacent to Aleppo's historic old quarter, as well as in Mahatat Baghdad and in Saadallah al-Jabiri Square. The Observatory reported four people killed in the city on Friday morning – three killed in shelling of the southern Fardoss district and one shot dead in the Maysaloon neighborhood. In Salaheddin, the scene of fierce fighting in recent days, hundreds of rebels were bracing for a threatened offensive by loyalist troops in Syria's commercial capital, which has been engulfed in violence since July 20.

***Iran bolsters retaliation capability in Persian Gulf, experts say**

Iran is rapidly gaining new capabilities to strike at U.S. warships in the Persian Gulf, amassing an arsenal of sophisticated anti-ship missiles while expanding its fleet of fast-attack boats and submarines, U.S. and Middle Eastern analysts say. The new systems, many of them developed with foreign assistance, are giving Iran's commanders new confidence that they could quickly damage or destroy U.S. ships if hostilities erupt, the officials say. Although U.S. Navy officials are convinced that they would prevail in a fight, Iran's advances have fueled concerns about U.S. vulnerabilities during the opening hours of a conflict in the gulf.

***Kurds prevent Iraqi troops from reaching Syria border**

Kurdish-Iraqi forces have prevented Iraqi military troops from reaching the border region between the Kurdistan region of Iraq and Syria, the secretary general of the Ministry of Peshmerga told AFP on Friday. Jabbar Yawar said: "Two days ago the Iraqi government sent military forces to the areas of Talafir and Sanajar in Mosul to protect the Iraqi-Syria border." "They are the tenth group to have come from Nasiriyah, southern Baghdad. The 32 regiment of this group tried to access Mosul at 6 o'clock coming from Rabia (North West Iraq) to Zamar, but were prevented by the Eighth brigade of the ministry of Peshmerga (Kurdish fighters) who asked them not to enter the territory." The border crossing between Syria and the Kurdistan region of western Iraq, which has been controlled by the Peshmerga since 1992, is near the town of Duhok.

***Syrian legislator from Aleppo defects to Turkey**

The Washington Post has just published an article with the very misleading title, "Turkey a hub for Syria revolution as illegal border crossing points abound," in which it describes "Salafi Muslims," who have "come to offer help from the countries of the Persian Gulf region" arming and joining the so-called "Free Syrian Army." The article also claims "weapons are ferried into Syria, delivered by Turkish military trucks and picked up by fighters on the other side in the dead of night." A more apt title would be, "Turkey hosts invading Saudi and Qatari mercenary army." This confirms earlier reports featured in the New York Times and the Washington Post, that not only are the Gulf States of Saudi Arabia and Qatar funding and arming militants via Turkey, but that the US is coordinating the logistical aspects of the operation as well.

***Two soldiers killed in blast in southeast Turkey**

Two Turkish soldiers were killed in the mainly Kurdish southeast on Friday when the vehicle they were traveling in was hit by a remote-controlled explosive, security sources said. A third soldier and one civilian were also wounded in the attack, which occurred around 7 a.m. (0500 GMT) near the town of Lice in Diyarbakir province, they said. Security officials blamed the attack on the outlawed Kurdistan Workers Party (PKK), which has waged a 27-year campaign against the Turkish state in which 40,000 people, mainly Kurds, have died. Explosives were buried in a road near military barracks and were set off by remote control when the vehicle carrying soldiers passed, the officials said. Turkey, the European Union and the United States all list the PKK as a "terrorist" organization.

***Turkey warns Assad that he must keep Kurds in check, or risk intervention**

President Bashar al-Assad, facing a growing rebel presence in Aleppo, Syria's largest city and its commercial hub, has turned control of parts of northern Syria over to militant Kurds who Turkey has long branded as terrorists, prompting concern that Istanbul might see the development as a reason to send troops across its border with Syria. Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan, in comments late on July 25, said that Turkey would not accept an entity in northern Syria governed by the Iraq-based Kurdistan Workers Party, or PKK, which has long waged a guerrilla war against Turkey, and its Syrian affiliate, the Democratic Union Party. He said the two groups had built a "structure in northern Syria" that for Turkey means "a structure of terror." "It is impossible for us to look favorably at such a structure," he said in an interview with a private television channel.

***Russia Seeks Naval Supply Bases in Cold War Allies Cuba, Vietnam**

***Russian, Western navies to face off near Syria**

***U.S. plans major exercises for Gulf, Mediterranean Sea in September**

Russia is in talks to set up naval bases in former Cold War allies Cuba and Vietnam as President Vladimir Putin undertakes the country's biggest military overhaul since the Soviet era. "We are working on establishing navy bases outside Russia," Vice-Admiral Viktor Chirkov said in an interview with the state-run RIA Novosti news service and confirmed by the navy. "We aim to set up resupply bases in Cuba, the Seychelles and Vietnam." Russian plans for overseas military expansion threatens to further strain relations with the U.S. at a time when the former superpower rivals are at loggerheads over American missile shield plans and fighting in Syria. Putin's government plans to spend 23 trillion rubles (\$712 billion) this decade on defense spending, including 4.4 trillion rubles next year, an increase of 19 percent. "There's a lot of tension

between Washington and Moscow right now as Syria is creating a lot of bad feeling between them," said Pavel Felgenhauer, an independent defense analyst in Moscow. "This will be seen by some in the U.S. as the Russian bear growling in its lair." Meanwhile, the United States has recruited more than 20 countries for two major naval exercises around the Middle East. U.S. Central Command has been planning two major exercises in the Middle East during 2012. The command said both exercises would take place in **September** and focus on anti-mine operations.

The Arab Spring in Prophecy

(Perilous Times Luke 21:9 & Nation against Nation, Kingdom against Kingdom Matt.24:7)

(Revelation 6:3-4 Revelation 6:8)

Luke 21:9 and Matthew 24:7 speak of nation against nation and kingdom against kingdom in the end times. Revelation 6:3-4 speaks of the fiery red horse given power to make men slay one another and Revelation 6:8 speaks again of this red horse in conjunction with the pale horse of Death and Hades, as the one that has the power to kill by sword.

I like to call this "The Arab Spring in Prophecy" because for us it is easy to identify- that's what the world calls it.

Luke 21:9: wars & commotions; the Greek word here is Akatastasia, meaning instability, a state of disorder, disturbance, confusion (revolutions)

Matthew 24:7: the Greek word for nation is **Ethnos** & refers to various ethnic groups fighting among themselves, where the next sentence in the verse refers to kingdoms (**basileiva**) fighting one another (not to be confused with an actual kingdom but rather the right or authority to rule over a kingdom)

***Sudanese struggle to ignite their own uprising**

"I think my country Sudan has really hit rock bottom." Those were the last public words uttered by Usamah Mohamad, a 32-year-old Sudanese web developer-turned-citizen journalist, in a video announcing he would join protests against President Omar al-Bashir. Mohamad, popular under his Twitter handle "simsimt," was arrested the same day his video was aired. For the next month, his family had no idea where he was. Finally they learned he was in Khartoum's high security prison and were allowed to visit him last week. Mohamad and hundreds of others - no less than 2,000, activists say - have been detained the past month in a campaign unleashed by the Sudanese government. The crackdown aims to crush a new attempt to launch a protest movement calling for the ouster of al-Bashir, inspired by the Middle East's uprisings that toppled the leaders of Sudan's neighbors Egypt and Libya as well as Tunisia and Yemen.

***Romanians rally to protest president's impeachment vote**

***Dissident groups join to reform IRA**

Dissident groups in Northern Ireland have joined to reclaim the banner of the IRA, members of the organization said. ***Death Toll In Southern Philippines Gun Battle Rises To 19**

The death toll resulting from fierce gun battle between government troops and Al Qaeda-linked Abu Sayyaf in the restive southern Philippines has reached 19, Xinhua news agency reported. A military official said at least 10 soldiers and nine Abu Sayyaf militants have been killed while 16 members of the government forces were wounded during the clash at the jungle of Sumisip town in Basilan province since Thursday. The official said ground forces had found eight wounded rebels among whom was the leader of the group identified as Wymys Wakil who was believed to have led the fighting. Regional military spokesman Randolph Cabangbang said the government's casualty figure was the result of two series of encounters that sparked Thursday morning, and another in the afternoon when the soldiers clashed with 50 gunmen linked with the Abu Sayyaf group. The military suffered eight deaths in the first encounter and another two later on Thursday afternoon.

***Refugees flee ethnic violence in India's troubled Assam**

Trucks loaded with women, children, mattresses and bags of rice rolled into a refugee camp in India's northeastern Assam state yesterday as security forces tried to stamp out the worst communal violence in a decade with shoot-on-sight orders. The death toll from clashes between Bodo tribespeople and Muslim settlers rose to 40 overnight, police said, after four more bodies were found. Police also opened fire on groups armed with sticks and spears for violating a curfew. Fearing for their lives, tens of thousands of Muslims and Bodos have fled their homes in remote hamlets along the border with Bhutan, and sought shelter in camps in larger towns. Roving armed bands have set ablaze hundreds of tin-roofed homes, many made of hay and clay, in the nearly week-long orgy of violence.
