
Rising number of fatal landslides makes 2019 the worst year on record

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
No one can deny the weird weather we have been witnessing nor the weather records being broken. The following news has become very common in these last days. “Tropical Storm "Hagibis" formed on October 5, 2019, and underwent one of the most **explosive intensification rates on record**. Hagibis exploded from a tropical storm with winds of 96 km/h (60 mph) to a Category 5 super typhoon with winds of 257 km/h

(160 mph) in just 18 hours as its center went close to the Northern Mariana Island of Anatahan, about 322 km (200 miles) northeast of Guam” (October 9, 2019 [The Watchers](#)).

Over and over again we are witnessing massive storms that continue to break all previous records. Case in point. Take a look a Cyclone Kyarr October 28, 2019.




A satellite image showing Cyclone Kyarr in the Arabian Sea.

“Cyclone Kyarr formed on Thursday and quickly spun up in the Indian Ocean into the most powerful storm on the planet. While the storm won’t have a huge impact on land, it’s already making its present felt in the record books in what’s been a weird and bad year in general for tropical cyclones, a classification that includes tropical storms, hurricanes, and typhoons as well. It’s currently packing winds of around 150 mph.” “Beyond individual superlatives, Kyarr also pushed the Indian Ocean to set a record for its most intense cyclone season on record” ([Gizmodo.com](#) Oct. 28, 2019)
